



TRAILBLAZERS WORLD YOUTH DAY 2008 DRESS CODE

All of the pilgrims to Sydney, Australia 2008 are expected to dress according to the following simple norms.

If you can't settle a doubt about how to dress, the Chaperones, Group Leaders should be consulted; the Director of Trailblazers Directors will be the ultimate arbiter.

1. We are traveling as pilgrims. "Pilgrims" does not mean bums. Everyone should dress respectfully and consider that we will be going to Mass and into churches each day. We probably won't have an opportunity to change clothes during the day.
2. For everyone
 - a. NO short shorts, tank tops, or spaghetti straps.
 - b. Walking shorts (not cut-offs) - just above the knee - are appropriate, or light weight long pants.
 - c. Polo shirts, cotton shirts, blouses and T-shirts (no inappropriate words, etc.) should be comfortable with layers for warmth in the evening and morning.
 - d. Clothing which is immodestly tight, revealing or form-fitting is not allowed.
 - e. Sleeping attire should be modest. All are required to wear some sort of pant (such as pajama or sweat-suit, shorts are fine) when going to bed, and not just underclothing; such wear must be modest. All men must wear at least some sort of under shirt and not go bare-backed. Trips to the restroom during curfew hours require modest attire.
3. A word to the ladies: We should dress modestly (Let's not be an occasion of sin). Knee-length skirts, split skirts or jumpers are fine. If in doubt, ask yourself, "Would Mary wear this?" However, we will be doing large amounts of hiking so take this into consideration when thinking about wearing a skirt.
